ASSIGNMENT: The Family Support Specialist for the Early Head Start (EHS) program operates as part of the Teaching and Learning department and is a member of the Child Care and Family Services team. The EHS Home-Based program is for low-income infants, toddlers, pregnant women and their families. The program seeks to enhance children's physical, social, emotional, and intellectual development, assist pregnant women to access comprehensive prenatal and postpartum care, support parents' efforts to fulfill their parental roles, and help parents move toward self-sufficiency.

This position is located at the Ocean Beach Early Learning Center and is available for a Part-Time (22 hrs/wk) or Full-Time (40 hrs/wk) assignment and will be working 245 days per year.

POSITION: Under the direction of the Early Learning Program Manager - Family Support, the Family Support Specialist I or II provides support services for pregnant women, toddlers, infants and families participating in the Early Head Start programs by identifying community resources and providing referrals and follow-up to meet family needs.
