Article VI. Conventions

Section 6. At any district convention, each club shall be entitled to seat up to three (3) delegates, two (2) of whom should be the club president and president-designate, as well as nominate three alternates who may serve if any delegate is absent. Club delegates and alternates shall be active members of the clubs they represent. However, the Lieutenant Governor or a past Lieutenant Governor a delegate-at-large may represent any club in their division not otherwise represented by three delegates, upon approval of said club. Delegates shall be elected by each club prior to the convention and certified to the district by the club president and secretary. A current or past Lieutenant Governor representing a club may be certified by the Credentials Committee or its designee.

Section 8. All officers, and past Governors, and all Past Lieutenant Governors, and all Lt. Governors-Designate, of the district who are active members of a club in the district shall be delegates-at-large to all district conventions.
