TENNIS CENTER SAND POINT TEAM GUIDELINES

Welcome to Tennis Center Sand Point Teams! We are happy to host USTA League Teams and Seattle Area Cup Tennis here at our facility.

All players playing on a USTA or Cup team must be TCSP members.

Team Policies

- 1. All players playing on a USTA or Cup Tennis team must be members of TCSP.
- 2. The captain is responsible for attending any league meetings and relaying league information to their team.
- 3. Team captains are responsible for contacting visiting team captains to share important club information on match fees and club policies.
- 4. Please notify the front desk 24 hours in advance for a match court cancellation or your team will be charged the full match fees.
- 5. All teams using Tennis Center Sand Point as a home court must practice out of TCSP.
- 6. Team Captains must fill out a TCSP Team Registration form listing all team members for each league.

Team Requests:

Members who wish to captain a USTA or Cup team out of TCSP must contact the team coordinator 8 weeks prior to the team confirmation form deadline. In the event that we have more team requests than spots available, TCSP will do a lottery 4 weeks prior to the team form deadline. When this is the case, TCSP will contact all captains with the lottery details.

Team Practices:

Team Practices are at the discretion of each team. While they are not required, we highly encourage practices for the advancement of your game. However, practice times are limited each season. In the event that TCSP has more practice requests than times available, a lottery will be held at the same time as the team lottery, or four weeks before team confirmation forms are due. Team practices can be arranged by emailing our team coordinator at teams@tenniscentersandpoint.com.

Team Practice Payments:

Tennis Center Sand Point will set the practice schedules for each team for the entire season. Team practice schedules will run in the same sessions as all TCSP programs. Team members will be charged for practices every 8 weeks or as determined by the team coordinator and the team captain. Players will pay \$17.50 per week of play for a two court practice and \$26.00 per week of play for a one court practice. The TCSP team coordinator has the right to add players to a team as needed and will always contact the team captain first.

Match Fees

Match fees are listed below. Teams will be responsible for paying for the entire match fee in one transaction, as the front desk will not collect individual payments at match time.
