Full payment is expected at each respective conference.
Please only bring one check per locality made payable to "Church in Anaheim-YP."

Conference Policy

1. All saints must register with their locality. Any new serving ones who have not served with us before must submit a serving ones application form (see page 7).
2. All young people attending these conferences **MUST** read the rules and regulations of the conference. They and their parents must sign that they have read and agreed to them and hand their signed agreement in to the responsible serving ones in their locality before they can be registered for the conference.
3. The Locality Contacts from each locality are responsible for registration of the saints in their respective locality. This must be done **ONLINE** by the due date. We have only provided one Locality Contact per locality with the password for the online registration system.
4. A current Medical Authorization Form (see page 6) for each young person must be in the vehicle they are traveling in. Young people should not travel without a valid Medical Authorization Form in the vehicle with them.
5. All payments must be paid when you arrive at the registration table in the meeting hall for your entire group. Please have ready one check per locality, payable to “The Church in Anaheim—Young People.”
6. Cancellations after the last Lord’s Day before the conference will be charged 50% of the conference fee. Cancellations made on the day of the conference will be charged full price. The only exceptions will be for sickness or unforeseen emergencies.

CONFERENCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No food, drink, or gum allowed in the meeting halls or the homes other than what is provided.
2. The Conference Schedule must be followed by everyone.
3. Attendance at all meetings (including home times and morning revival) is mandatory. In case of sickness, appropriate medical attention will be obtained and parents may be asked to come take the sick child home.
4. During home times, everyone is encouraged to participate.
5. Respect and thank your host. If you have a problem, tell your serving one who will tell the coordinating brothers. DO NOT go to the host directly.
6. Take care of the homes. Pick up any paper, soda cans, or trash you see on the ground. Make your bed, offer to help clean the dishes, vacuum and clean the rooms.
7. No one may leave the homes at any time.
8. Serving ones are permitted to rise before the scheduled rising time as long as they do not waken others.
9. Take short showers.
10. There must not be any excessive noise or shouting outdoors early in the morning or after the evening meeting in order not to disturb the neighbors.
11. NO ELECTRONIC ITEMS ARE ALLOWED (CELL PHONES, TVs, LAPTOPS, RADIOS, PDAs, IPODs, MP3 players, etc.) to be used in the homes of the saints.
12. NO UNSANCTIFIED ITEMS such as playing cards, novels or magazines are allowed in the homes or to be used in the homes whether brought by the young people or provided by the hosts.
13. Lights out at scheduled time. That means no talking, and no leaving the home during the night.
14. All clothing worn during the entire weekend must be proper and modest. No shorts may be worn during the meetings. No open toe shoes. No clothing, caps, or shirts with improper pictures, logos, or symbols may be worn.
15. Additional rules may be added during the conference.
16. The serving ones are responsible to see that the young people from their locality follow these instructions.

I hereby waive all claims of liability against SCYP, Engedi Home and Conference Center ("ECCC"), Living Stream Ministry ("LSM"), and any of the local churches, and their respective officers, members, agents, or employees should my application be denied for any reason. I also agree to defend, hold harmless, and indemnify SCYP, ECCC, LSM, and any of the local churches, and their respective officers, members, agents, or employees from any liability, damage, or loss resulting from this consent to background check.
