Adult WNL Courses

Effective Parenting in a Defective World

Led by Rev. Sam Martin

Using lessons from Chip Ingrim, this class will help participants learn to raise kids who stand out from the crowd. Sessions will focus on: Learning universally applicable principles that will change your understanding of your role as a parent and how to apply God's process for teaching and nurturing your children; applying practical lessons about discipline, including a biblical understanding of punishment versus discipline, and the importance of maintaining the right attitude; and understanding and implementing simple biblical truths. COST: \$10 per study guide.

Bonboeffer: Pastor, Martyr, Prophet, and Spy

Led by Billie Young

This course will combine a 4-session video study on the major themes of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's writings based on the biography by bestselling author, Eric Metaxas with a four-week video study based on Pastor Adam Hamilton's book, *Forgiveness: Finding Peace Through Letting Go.* We will begin by discovering how Bonhoeffer transformed an entire faith community in Germany during World War II with his deeply held spiritual beliefs. The four riveting video sessions touch on the church; life together; cheap grace; religionless Christianity; and more. Then, we will turn to Rev. Hamilton to learn how to receive the freedom that comes with forgiving—even if the person who needs grace is yourself!

"Armor of God" Priscilla Shirer Women's Study

The Armor of God, more than merely a biblical description of the believer's inventory, is an action plan for putting it on and developing a personalized strategy to secure victory.
