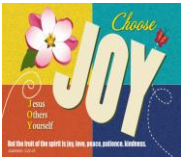
SAVE THE DATE We will visit Florence Crittenton Monday, August 24th.

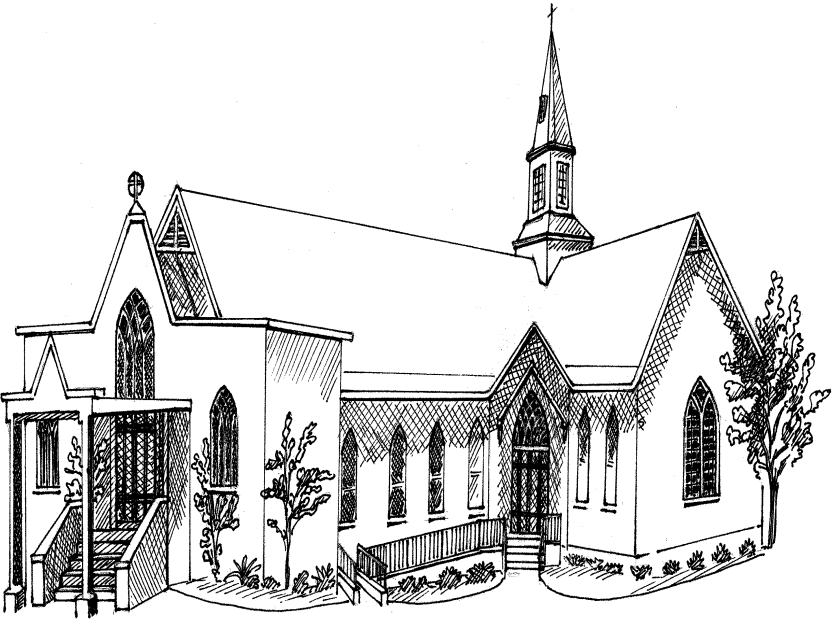
