Jack Koenig Designs Winning Jersey For Lexington Legends



When Jack Koenig was five years old, his parents took him to his pediatrician after he complained of pain in his feet which became particularly acute when he played soccer and basketball. His pediatrician sent him to Lexington Orthopedic Associates for further evaluation.

After trying various shoe inserts, Jack continued to experience pain. The physicians at Lexington Orthopedic Associates referred Jack to Janet Walker, M.D., pediatric orthopedic surgeon at Shriners Hospitals for Children—Lexington. There, Dr. Walker determined that the tibias in Jack's lower legs were twisted, causing his ankles to turn outward. She prescribed a corrective brace to be worn for a month to align his feet, and the orthotics department created custom inserts for Jack's shoes for arch support. Although he no longer requires the brace, Jack continues to work with his physical therapist, Kasey Kasak, at the Lexington Shriners Hospital on a weekly basis to improve his strength, stability, and alignment when he walks.

It was at one of these weekly appointments that he first saw the flyer for the Lexington Legends' Design-A-Jersey contest. All patients were given the opportunity to design a jersey to be worn by the Legends, Lexington's minor league baseball team, at an upcoming home game. "We got a lot of great entries," Mike Allison, on-field personality for the Lexington Legends, "but the mustache on Jack's design pushed his to the top."

As the winner, Jack received his own custom jersey and threw out an opening pitch for the game. Jerseys worn by the players were auctioned off after the game, and brought in over \$2000 for the hospital. Before the game started, he was asked to speak to the record-breaking crowd. "Shriners helps all sorts of kids," he said with a smile, microphone in hand, "and they've definitely helped me a lot."

As the winner, Jack received his own custom jersey and threw out an opening pitch for the game. Jerseys worn by the players were auctioned off after the game, and brought in over \$2000 for the hospital. Before the game started, he was asked to speak to the record-breaking crowd. 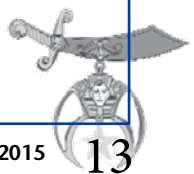
