**Judge Evans** received her high school diploma in Halifax County, graduated Magna Cum Laude at North Carolina Central University with a Bachelors of Art. Continued at NCCU pursued her Juris Doctorate and became licensed to practice law in 1984. She went into private practice in Durham until 1990, and then became the Assistant District Attorney for the fourteenth Judicial District in Durham.

In 1994 Pat made a decision that would make history in Durham, She decided to run for District Attorney of Durham County. Her platform was "Stop the Violence". Although she did not win the election, she was the first African –American female to seek that office. Despite the election results, Pat dedicated herself to serving her Durham community in other ways. She has served on many Boards of Directors; including what was then Durham County Mental Health, Urban Ministries of Durham, Durham County Bar Association, Durham Chapter of the American Red Cross, New Horizons Character and Leadership Academy and Project Excellence. She has also served as an instructor for the Durham Police Department. Additionally, Pat has served in organizations such as; tutoring at-risk children, teaching Sunday school, volunteering her time at the public schools, and food banks.

Currently, **Judge Pat Evans** serves as a District Court Judge for the 14<sup>th</sup> Judicial District. She presides over Criminal, Family, Child Support, Civil Jury, Juvenile Delinquency, Traffic, Community Life, Domestic Violence and People' Courts. She has also served as the Adult Drug Treatment Court Judge.

In keeping with her status as a true public servant, Pat has enjoyed serving the underserved and underrepresented in her beloved community in various capacities. Her participation and tireless dedication has surely brought Pat Many accolades. She is known for acknowledging that her most rewarding achievement is her personal relationship with God and bestowed blessing of a loving husband, wonderful children and grandchildren, and amazing friends.
