There will be 21 sessions in eight different fields such as wastewater/water, sustainability and asset management. Finally, on Thursday evening we host our Crab Crawl social event. The Crab Crawl will have multiple stops and end at the Public Works Museum.

On Friday attendees will have the option to attend 23 education sessions in seven different fields. Some these fields include Historic Preservation and Parks & Grounds, Engineering/Technology and IT/GIS Applications, Workforce Development and Solid Waste/Recycling. Finally we will close our conference with door prizes for our attendees.

During the course of this conference we will work on providing professional development opportunities and be a catalyst for attendees to build relationships with peers who face the same challenges.
