



Mystery in the Tea Shop

A FUN MYSTERY QUILT PATTERN brought to you by

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GENERAL INFO & hints: Mystery in the Tea Shop is a beautiful quilt that will measure 36" x 45" without borders, and with borders 50" x 59". (More blocks and/or more borders can be added if you need a larger quilt, however the Fabric Requirements shown below are for the sizes mentioned above.) You'll want to choose fabrics with good contrast. Feel free to make it scrappy or stick with just two colors. Your block size will be 9" square. Setting for this quilt is 4 blocks x 5 blocks. No special tools are needed, just your trusty sewing machine and favorite tools! This pattern assumes you have basic quilting skills & knowledge, however if you have any questions be sure to make contact with the shop!

Hints about COLOR CHOICES for Mystery in the Tea Shop: Blue Willow, Orange Pekoe, Earl Gray, Chai Spice

Fabric Requirements:

Blocks: Light: 1 1/4 yard; Dark: 1 1/2 yard

Inner Border and Binding: 1 yard

Outer Border: 1 yard



STEP 1 (Cutting)

LIGHT: Cut four 3 7/8" strips selvage to selvage; sub-cut into 40) 3 7/8" squares

Cut five 4 1/4" strips selvage to selvage; sub-cut into 40) 4 1/4" squares; Cut each square twice diagonally to make 160 triangles.

DARK: Cut two strips selvage to selvage; sub-cut into twenty 3 1/2" squares

Cut four 3 7/8" strips; sub-cut into forty 3 7/8" squares

Cut ten 2 3/8" strips; sub-cut into 160) 2 3/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make 320 triangles.

INNER BORDER & BINDING: Cut five 2 1/2" strips (border); Cut six 2 1/4" strips (binding)

OUTER BORDER: Cut six 5 1/2" strips

ANOTHER HINT: It's a good idea to save the above units in LABELED sandwich bags!!!!

WE PROMISE that you have the majority of the cutting finished! So, take a break, steep a cup of tea (or sip your favorite beverage), and **RELAX until STEP 2 arrives!**
