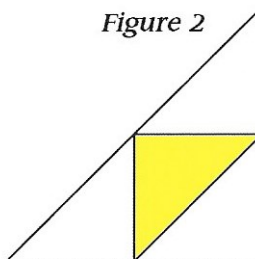


## MYSTERY AT THE HOMESTEAD, STEP 3

Add a LIGHT half-square triangle to the MEDIUM COLORED sides of the squares made in last week's step. This makes a triangle unit. (See Figure 2).

Make 48 of these triangular units. :-)

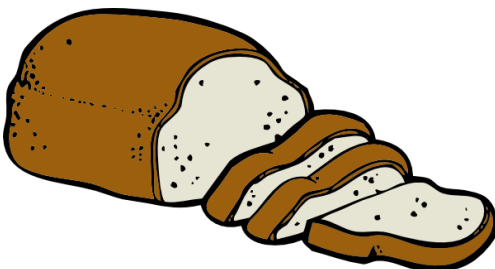

**THE SCENT OF BAKING BANANA BREAD WILL FLOAT TO EVERY CROOK AND CRANNIE OF  
YOUR HOMESTEAD! (And your family will thank you!)**

### AUNT LIL'S BANANA BREAD

1/2 C. CHOPPED NUTS, 1 C. mashed bananas (2 med., not over ripe), 1 1/2 cups flour, 1 tsp. baking soda, 1/2 tsp salt, 1/2 cup soft butter, 1 cup sugar, 2 eggs, 1/2 cup sour cream or buttermilk, 1 tsp. vanilla



Sift together flour, soda, salt & set aside. In a separate bowl, cream butter and sugar. To the butter mixture, add egg, vanilla, and the flour mixture. Stir, then add bananas, sour cream & nuts. If you use one big bread pan, bake for 1 hour at 350. Two smaller pans, bake at 350 for 20-25 minutes. (Use a BIG PAN for a entire hour at your sewing machine!)
