What is it?

The Community Living Attendant Training Program, based out of Grande Prairie, prepares students with theory and practical skills to provide a flexible array of supports specific to each consumer/employer's unique independent living needs.

Being a Home Host

Home Hosts would invite CLAT students into their home to observe their regular caregiver conduct their normal care routine on day one, allowing the student to provide care with the regular caregiver present for the rest of the work week (note: placement students are not permitted to provide care without the regular caregiver present).

Placement Dates

Three one week placements for the week of October 27, November 3, and November 10, 2014 (note: there will be no placements on holidays). We would also like to hear from consumers looking for caregiver employees. Our students will be looking for work when the program is complete on November 14, 2014.
