ministry together. We hope and expect that we will all enjoy seeing one another offering our gifts and our time to God and others at St. David's and in the world.



St. David's also contributes financially to IHN, which, in turn, provides needed job training and counseling. Recently, Tamea, a mom with two young children, found full-time employment, and the family has been approved for housing!

WHAT IS MYSTDAVIDS?


