

The minimum age for attendees is 14 years (by June 29, 2016).


Young adults are aged 18-35 years (by June 29, 2016).


Florida Conference Working Policy [emphasis in the original]

<u>REGISTRATION</u> - All Registrations for Red Zone will be done through the FL Conference Youth Ministries Department. Please do NOT contact Camp Kulaqua directly – they will send you back to our office. <u>COST</u> - The participant fee for the weekend is \$3/person (until May 13) or \$5/person (after May 13).

<u>HOUSING</u> - Camp Kulaqua will have housing available - <u>through our office ONLY</u> (please do not call Kulaqua re: housing) Booked through our office (link above). Red Zone fee still applies (\$3/person or \$5/person) for those staying off site.

Here's what is available:

(Cost is for unit/not per person)

Chalets – (2 rooms/1 bathroom/sleeps 4-6); \$95/night Chalets – (2 rooms/2 bathroom/sleeps 4-6); \$95/night

Woodland Lodge - (2 queen beds, 1 bunk bed set, 1 sofa bed/sleeps 8); \$105/night

Mini-Lodges (4 rooms/3 bathrooms/sleeps 18-24 people); \$195/night

Rustic Cabins (2 sides/shared bathroom/sleeps 10/5 per side); \$35/side/night

RV sites -full hook-up; \$20/night

<u>ARRIVAL</u> - Please plan to arrive <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 27</u> and check-in <u>between 4:00-7:00 pm</u>. Check-ln will begin @ 4:00 pm (no one allowed in until 4pm). For those that tent camp, please plan to have your camping areas set up before Sabbath. <u>CAMPING</u> - Camp Kulaqua will offer us plenty of tent camping spaces; clubs will camp by areas (N/C/S).

<u>FOOD VENDORS</u> - Clubs must apply to become an official food vendor (small deposit required AND must be in designated area only). This is a fundraising opportunity. Total number of vendors is limited to 12 (first come/first serve).

GOLF CARTS - No personal golf carts are permitted. Limited golf carts are available for rent, if there is proof of a medical condition

(\$100/for weekend); all drivers must have a valid driver's license and be at least 21 years old.

<u>HOTELS</u> - To supplement housing needs, here is a list of hotels within 20-30 miles from Camp Kulaqua. We will get group rates; identify yourself as with Red Zone. To download the list, click here: http://tinyurl.com/CKhotels

MEALS - Camp Kulaqua WILL be offering meals at a discount (\$8.50/adults & 7.50/child). Contact CAMP to buy tickets.

SABBATH GUESTS/VISITORS - This is a paid event; any visitor coming for a few hours will need to check in at the main gate with security. In order to enter, an adult from the club they are visiting will need to meet the guest at the gate to verify they are with their club. The guest will sign in and be allowed to enter. Guests should sign out when they leave.

PETS - NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON CAMPUS

<u>WATER PARK</u> - (River Ranch) – Camp Kulaqua will open the Water Park (lazy river, wave pool and water slide) for us on Sunday, May 29. Cost is \$10/person – in advance (by May 13). Cost is \$15/person (after May 13).

<u>WHEELS</u> - Please do not bring any bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, etc. If it has wheels – please leave it at home.

ZOO – The Camp Zoo will be open on Sabbath afternoon as part of the afternoon activities. (No charge).

And there shall be a time of trouble, Such as never was since there was a nation, even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book. Daniel 12:1

It's hard to imagine a more scary time than the lasts days of earth's history—the last days before Jesus returns. It is so tempting and easy to ignore this coming reality and live life as if it will never happen. However, Jesus' advice was to watch (Mark 13:37).

Do I know how to survive in the wild?

How can I be both ready to go, and prepared to stay?

Perhaps you've asked yourself similar questions? Perhaps you've become more interested in living off the grid and being self-sufficient. you've noticed world events and the craziness of our society. Or maybe you have come to the conclusion that God is coming is real soon. All these are just some of the ways in which the Holy Spirit works, prompting us to get ready. But what do you do to get ready? The first thing is to sort out your relationship wit God. After that you're going to have to seriously consider preparing yourself to live without your normal comforts of home.

Our Wilderness Survival Camp will teach you many valuable skills about survival living: staring a fire without a match, water purification survival equipment, shelter, backpacks, and much more.

It will be held at Camp Kulaqua from July 22-24. The cost is \$55. No food or accommodation is provided. You'll need to bring your camping equipment. Do not buy specialized survival equipment until you've been through this training.


