1. What is FOR-Rockland's mission?

Our mission is to promote a positive view of recovery from addictions and to educate communities about the effective outcomes associated with receiving appropriate information, treatment, and support. Our goals are for all community members to have a common language, an understanding of how recovery works, and to gain community support for this positive movement.

2. Who are your members?

FOR-Rockland is comprised of Rockland County residents who are in long-term recovery from addiction along with their families and allies. We represent all sectors of the community, all regions of the state, and the numerous and diverse pathways to recovery.

3. What types of activities does Rockland conduct

We actively organize and mobilize the Rockland recovery community to speak effectively with one voice. We advocate for policies and legislation that assure sufficient resources for prevention, treatment, and recovery support for all members of the community. We've hosted a variety of programs including a screening of The Anonymous People and chartering a bus for Rockland recovery allies to travel to the Unite to Face Addiction rally in Washington, D.C. last October. We're partnering with FOR-NY to host a community listening forum on April 28th.
