On-site childcare will be provided, free of charge. Please RSVP if you will be bringing a child.

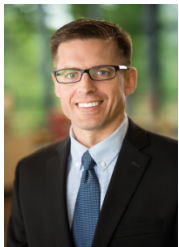
People of the Way: Renewing Episcopal Identity

with the Rev. Dr. Dwight Zscheile

Once upon a time, the Episcopal Church was grounded in its identity as the church of the elites, the de facto “national church” of the United States. Those days are gone. But if the Episcopal Church is no longer the church of the establishment, what is the heart of Episcopal identity and mission?

Scholar and Episcopal priest Dwight Zscheile will help us reflect on the massive shift in cultural and religious landscape, ground ourselves in Scripture to recall how God has acted among and through God’s people in other times of change and struggle, and offer us stories, tools, and practices for the vital and collaborative work of re-imagining what it means to be Episcopalian in America today, carrying forward the best of our heritage while adapting to connect with new populations and generations.



Dwight Zscheile is an Episcopal priest, associate professor of congregational mission and leadership at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota. He is the author of *The Agile Church: Spirit-Led Innovation in an Uncertain Age* (Morehouse Publishing, 2014), *People of the Way: Renewing Episcopal Identity* (Morehouse Publishing, 2012), and more, and has spoken at many diocesan conventions and clergy days around the country. **We will have a copy of People of the Way for those attending.**
