6. Representing St. John Bosco at functions of the Diocese of Phoenix, City and State.
7. Active input of ideas for promoting St. John Bosco Catholic School.

Expectations include:

1. Solid academic standing with a cumulative G.P.A. of 80% or above.
2. Knowledgeable about St. John Bosco Catholic School and the community.
3. Active participation in one or more co-curricular activities, clubs or athletics.
4. Neatly groomed and appropriately dressed when dealing with prospective students and their families.
5. Willing to participate when needed; polite, courteous, friendly, understanding, enthusiastic and helpful.
6. Demonstrates leadership through Gospel-rooted service involvement and active participation in parish.
7. Attend at least three events throughout the 2015 - 16 school year (one per trimester).
8. Attend summer training class prior to start of school year, scheduled for Wednesday, August 12, 2015.
