Early elementary-aged children experience, learn and practice the most foundational elements of our Unitarian Universalist theology. Children learn the concept of the covenant, the basis of our congregational organization, through building group covenants and learning the “7 Principles” that are the greater covenant of our movement. They explore the “6 Sources” affirmed as wells from which to draw faith and inspiration, from the world’s wisdom traditions to the importance of valuing science and reason. They come to understand the meaning of “Unitarian” and “Universalist” theologies, and learn about the past and present women, men and children who have given birth to and guided our movement. These groups use the *Tapestry of Faith* curricula.
