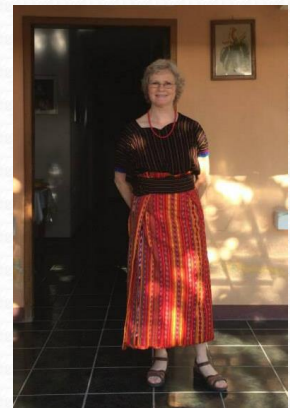
Alfredo Sical Toj

Phyllis Morales runs the scholarship program at Jefferson Unitarian Church and has led a number of trips to visit the scholarship students in Rabinal. Marwin Xitumul and Alfredo Sical Toj are human rights workers in Rabinal; Juan de Dios, founder of the scholarship program, is a survivor of the massacres and the scorched earth tactics directed against Mayan villages. Dios has directed ADIVIMA, a Mayan human rights organization, since 1999. ADIVIMA has been active in organizing the Mayan people for their human rights, for reparations for the massacres that took place in the 1980's, for organizing to bring those responsible for the genocide to trial, and for educating the children of families who suffered from the genocide.
