Beach Cities Transit Announces Upcoming Service Changes Effective August 25, 2012

REDONDO BEACH, Calif.- Beach Cities Transit (BCT) has announced three upcoming service changes effective Saturday, August 25, 2012. The service improvements are part of the transit agency's service plan changes that are based on the Comprehensive Operational Analysis study that was completed in August 2011. Community meetings were held September 26 through October 6, 2011 to present proposed service changes and take public comment. The Public Hearing was held at the Redondo Beach City Council meeting on November 15, 2011, and the service changes were approved by the City Council.

The Comprehensive Operational Analysis included the fixed route line-by-line analysis and the WAVE Dial A Ride service analysis. The studies examined how Beach Cities Transit and WAVE Dial A Ride services are being used, each line's productivity and use patterns, and how effective the systems are working.

Several important service changes include route and time schedules improvements on BCT Lines 102 and 109, and the discontinuation of Line 104. The proposed service adjustments modify routes and schedules to allocate resources to the most productive services that currently interface with the Metro Bus and Rail, Torrance Transit, Gardena Municipal Bus Lines, LADOT Commuter Express, Lawndale Beat and Palos Verdes Peninsula Transit Authority.

BCT Fixed Route Service Changes

BCT Service changes are effective August 25, 2012. Please check www.beachcitiestransit.org for bus map and time schedule information.

1) BCT Line 104:

- Discontinue BCT Line 104

2) BCT Line 102:

- Time schedules will be revised to improve services
- Additional weekday bus trips will be added during the school year
- South Bay Galleria will be served in both northbound and southbound directions during non-peak hours

3) BCT Line 109:

- Time schedules will be revised to improve services
- Metro Green Line Douglas Station will be served in both northbound and southbound directions
- Eastbound service to Manhattan Village Mall will be re-routed from Rosecrans Avenue/Village Drive to Village Drive, Park View Avenue, and Market Place
