CODE SEMINAR: Significant Changes to 2012 IBC

Led by ICC Instructor Jay Woodward

>> As many of you know, the adoption of the IBC 2012 by the State of Michigan, and incorporation into the 2012 MBC was completed in 2014. The current 2012 MBC is anticipated to be in enforcement for at least the next 2 years at the state level. Join us as we bring in an expert from ICC to highlight items you may not know have changed.

Excerpted from the ICC website: This program overviews the changes from the 2009 to the 2012 IBC®. Identifies changes in organization and code requirements and the applicability of these requirements to design, plan review and inspection. This course uses the Significant Changes to the International Building Code 2012 Edition.
