### ABOUT THE BOARD OF BUILDING STANDARDS

The Board of Building Standards formulates and adopts rules governing the erection, construction, repair, alteration, and maintenance of all buildings or classes of buildings specified in Section 3781.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Board also governs the installation of equipment and materials used in these buildings.

### ABOUT THE POSITION

In this position, the successful candidate will be actively involved in most aspects of residential and non-residential building code development, training, and technical support. A regular part of the job duties involve review of national model code changes, research and writing technical articles and papers, and responding to code questions from other state departments, boards, administrative agencies, legislators, professional, public, and private interest groups & individuals. Staff also performs field visits, investigations, and reviews of non-residential and residential building department operations - including their general administrative operations, plan review, & inspection processes – and evaluation of the actions of non-residential and residential building department personnel reporting findings to the Board.
