



2016 AIA Flint Chapter Design Awards Program

CALL FOR ENTRIES

The AIA Flint is inviting members of its chapter to submit your best work for a juried Design Awards Program. Through the Design Awards program, the AIA Flint will recognize the design excellence of its members. It serves to promote the value of good design and the commitment of local architects to the community in which they live and work. It will also be a chance for the architects to honor and acknowledge the contributions of the clients for whom the work has been done.

Submitted entries will be judged by architects from the AIA Huron Valley. The projects will be judged individually, not in competition with each other. The jury will be encouraged, but not required, to select for recognition a minimum of one project per category. Additional awards may be awarded if the judges see fit.

The Reception for the Design Awards Program and Celebration of Great Design will be Friday July 8th, 2016 in conjunction with the second Friday ArtWalk in downtown Flint. The submission dates are as follows:

- April 15 Request for submittals and announcement of Awards Program
- May 12 Submittals are due to AIA-Flint
- May 20 Submissions sent to judges at Huron Valley AIA Chapter
- June 10 Results received from judges
- June 10-July 1st Boards for public display made by awardees for display at Art Walk
- July 8 Reception to announce winners at ArtWalk event

The reception location has not yet been determined.

AIA Flint Chapter Design Awards Program Outline

Two levels of Awards for possible selection

Honor Award – highest distinction

Honorable Mention – at jury's discretion

Seven Categories

- Building Award
- Interior Architecture Award
- Sustainable Design Award
- Urban Design Award
- Small Commercial Design Award (Under \$500,000 in Construction Value)
- Residential Architecture Award
- Historic Preservation and/or Adaptive Reuse Project Award
- Legacy Award (> 5 years, not received previous AIA Flint award)
- Unbuilt Project Award

General Criteria

- Work must be by architects/firms who are members of the AIA Flint Chapter
- If multi-office firm, work by office in the AIA Flint Chapter
- Shall be completed projects
- Work completed in the last 5 yrs (except for Legacy which must >than 5 yrs)
- All submissions will be displayed at ArtWalk and on AIA Flint Website

Registration entry fee to be \$200 per submission, no limit on submissions.

Plaque will be awarded to winning entries, certificate for honorable mentions.

Submission format

The format shall be provided as a PowerPoint slide presentation. Additional submission information will be provided via email once entry form is received.

Submission Checklist

A single PowerPoint presentation for each submission shall be submitted for judging. A powerpoint with a maximum of 18 slides shall be submitted with all included images at 200 dpi. Powerpoint should be in .pdf format so no alterations may be made to the submitted entries. These submissions will be transferred electronically to the judges.

Judging will be performed by members of AIA Huron Valley.

Each submission should include:

- A narrative page describing the Project name and location, category, completion date, and written statement which briefly and concisely describes the project being submitted. The written statement shall include a design statement outlining the design problem and solution, site description (if appropriate), project square footage and cost, Indicate whether the project is new construction, an addition, renovation, restoration or interior architecture.
- Suggested images for the presentations could include:
 - Site Plan
 - Floor Plan(s)
 - Elevations and Sections
 - Photographic Images
- No identification of the firm or architect shall be on any part of the submission.
- Please limit presentation size to 1GB.

Sealed Descriptive Data Sheet: Included in the submission shall be a descriptive data sheet sealed in an envelope containing name and location of project, name and address of firm, name of architect and title, name of owner (or developer), name of contractor or construction manager, and any other credits (consultants, team members, etc.), name, telephone and email of contact person.

Printed Presentation

A printed presentation board(s) should be prepared by the entrant for the Reception. The boards shall be 24"x36". The number of boards and the content of each shall be the entrant's responsibility. The boards are to be delivered to the offices of Gazall Lewis Architects no later than July 1st. The cost of printing and preparation of the boards shall also be the entrant's responsibility.
