The American Institute of Architects Flint Chapter, jointly with AIA National, is pleased to announce the recipients for this year's architecture scholarships:

Trent Joseph Schmitz, of Montrose, a Hill-McCloy High School graduate, will be attending Lawrence Tech. University, has been awarded a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000.00.

The AIA Flint scholarship fund was established to encourage and assist students graduating from high school in the Flint Chapter region, which consists of Genesee, Shiawassee, and Lapeer Counties, and existing college students. The purpose is to assist students to pursue a professional degree in architecture at a college or university with an NAAB accredited architecture program, or an associate degree in architectural technology. Contributions to the fund primarily come through proceeds from the annual golf outing, as well as matching grant monies received from AIA National. The fund is administered by the AIA Flint Chapter of the American Institute of Architects.

The awards were presented to the recipients during a ceremony on Friday, August 28, 2015 at the AIA Flint Chapter annual golf outing at the Coyote Preserve Golf Club in Fenton.
