Sunday March 20 11:00 AM til 5:00pm

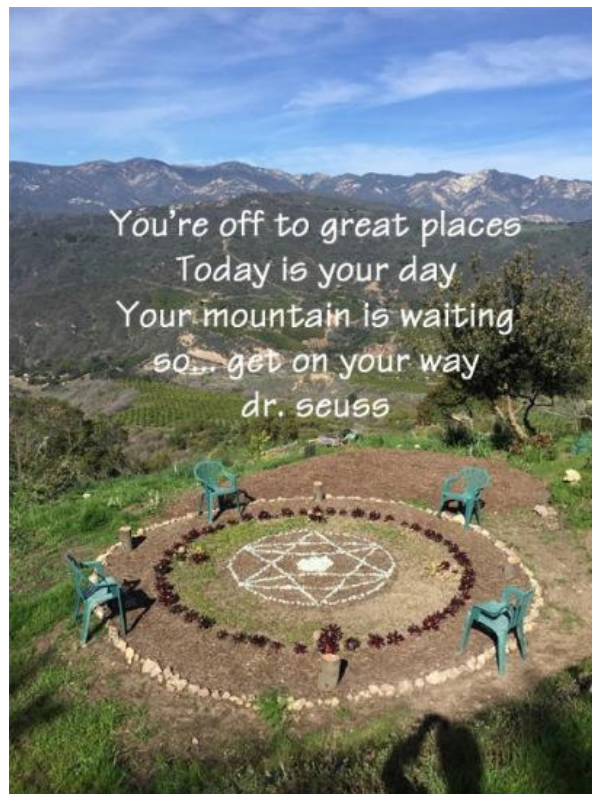
Art Cisneros will be doing a fire ceremony and keeping the fire

Here are the driving directions to ChaskaNorte Sanctuary from the 101 Freeway:

It takes 30-40 mins from Santa Barbara, Ventura and Ojai.

Take 101 to the Highway 150 – Ojai and Lake Casitas turnoff (the next exit past Ballard when you're coming from Santa Barbara)

Three miles from the freeway turn off is the gate. There is a call box on the left and the gate is on the right.

When you see the black chain link fence on the right, pull in. There is a sign that says Ocean View Road 1.8 mi. There is also a sign on the gate that says Block 6500, and a sign that says Rincon Mountain Road- and also a bunch of real estate signs.

The gate may be open. If not, there is a box where you put a code in. Push 011 and that will call me and I will open the gate.

Where you are going is 8599 Ocean View Road. Do not try getting there with your GPS. It won't work. I just checked again...

Go through the gate and go up up up to the very top (it will take about 10 minutes to go the 1.8 miles - you will be driving s-l-o-w-l-y).

You will come to T where there is a stop sign (and have a nice ocean view if it is clear). Turn left at the T. (There is even a sign that says Ocean View Road!)

Continue for a little less than a mile, losing that ocean view. You'll eventually go up and over a hill then down to where the paved road turns to a gravel road.

Go on the gravel road just a little ways - there will be some parking signs
