Re: Conservation of Wild Cherry Canyon

I am writing in support of conservation of PG&E Lands including Wild Cherry Canyon, in San Luis Obispo County. In 2000, voters in San Luis Obispo County overwhelmingly approved Measure A/Dream Initiative that urged PG&E to conserve this land and make it publicly accessible.

Conservation (NOT development) is also consistent with PG&E's own vision for the property as articulated in recent years.

Most importantly, PG&E should NOT SELL its underlying fee title on Wild Cherry Canyon to HomeFed. This would facilitate the property's development, and undermine any real conservation outcome.
