About the Neighborhood Summit

On Saturday, September 26, 2015 The Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta will convene the 2015 Regional Neighborhood Summit. This one-day gathering held at the Georgia International Convention Center is an opportunity for our region's community and neighborhood leaders to connect with one another, learn from each other and advance their vision for metro Atlanta. We will engage more than 800 attendees within the 23-county region through workshops, plenary sessions and small group consulting.

Theme

This year's theme, "Embracing the Power of Education," is focused on the educational pipeline from birth to career. Workshops will highlight the continuum of education that begins at birth and is carried on through school, college and career. Presenters will include leaders throughout the education continuum. This includes representatives from the early education, K through 12, post-secondary and workforce fields. Attendees will include civic, public and private stakeholders committed to helping children succeed from birth through career.
