SUPER SUMMER Rules and Helpful Tips

YOU PACK YOUR CLOTHES!

Super Summer Dress Code Expectations

Casual clothing is acceptable during all activities at Super Summer. Sleeveless clothing is not allowed. Shorts, skirts, or dresses must be at least fingertip length. Students wearing inappropriate clothing (i.e., sheer or tight clothing) will be asked to change. Students should wear clothes that will allow them to be comfortable sitting on the ground/in the grass at various times of the day and night.

Helpful 1'4' Don't unpack completely until Tuesday morning.

The Super Summer office may have to move you to another room after Monday check-in is completed. Stay in the room assigned to you. Room changes are made only to help assure that each student has at least one roommate (whenever possible), and changes are authorized ONLY through the Super Summer office.

SOME HELPFUL DEFINITIONS FOR FIRST-TIME SUPER SUMMER PARTICIPANTS:

- **<u>TL</u>**: Team Leader (the amazing people who will spend time with you during Super Summer).
- Family Group Time: A small group you are assigned to for discussion and prayer within your age group.
- Rainbow Worship Service: The worship service when all the schools gather together in the evenings.
- <u>Cloudburst</u>: Cloudburst is your first meeting after Check-in on Monday. Doors open at 3:15 PM.
- <u>Texas Olympics and Wild & Crazy Games</u>: Daily recreation time.
- SonRise Service: Final worship service at the end of the week before your last School Session.
- Super Summer: The best week of your life!

Your first meeting after check-in on Monday is at 3:15 PM is Cloudburst.

When you arrive on campus, you'll receive yourname tag, spirit shirt, check-in card, and curriculum for the week.

Cloudburst is **MANDATORY** for everyone attending Super Summer.

At Cloudburst, you'll be introduced to the Speaker and Worship Leader for the week! You'll also see cool videos introducing Marketing Staff, Athletic Staff, and the Rules.

Your School Group Photos* will be taken immediately after Cloudburst/Orientation.

- 1. Students are not allowed off campus.
- Late arrivals and/or early checkouts are not permitted.
- Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle.
- Students must attend all scheduled activities.
- Students who are ill or injured must stay in the Super Summer Medical Clinic (or hospital).
- Students must indicate which medications they will use at Super Summer; medications will not be shared.
- Students must be in their dorm each night by 10:30 PM. Lights will go out at 11:00 PM.
- Under no circumstances are girls allowed in boys' rooms or boys in girls' rooms.
