### **HINSDALE CHORALE PRESENTS "HARMONIC IMPRESSIONS" SUNDAY, MAY 1, IN LA GRANGE**

Hinsdale, Ill. – April 5, 2016 – The Hinsdale Chorale will perform "Harmonic Impressions," the group's annual spring concert, Sunday, May 1, 2016, at 3:00 p.m., at Emmanuel Episcopal Church of LaGrange, 203 S. Kensington, LaGrange. The concert is presented under the direction of Hinsdale Chorale Music Director and Conductor Bruce Hall and accompanied by Kathy Christian. Under Hall's direction since the fall of 2014, the Chorale has swelled to a total of 28 voices from 17 different communities in Chicago's western suburbs.

The program is an eclectic harmonic mix, beginning with a clever arrangement of British Baroque composer Henry Purcell's "Music for a While" with the Chorale serving as orchestra. Selections from music theater and opera will also be featured, including Philip Glass' "Akhnaten," Leonard Bernstein's "Candide," and Aaron Copland's "The Tender Land." In addition, the program includes music composed or arranged by Illinois composers Frank Ferko, Paul Caldwell, and the Chorale's very own bass section member Allan Peterson.

"I am thrilled to conclude my second season with the wonderful Hinsdale Chorale," said Hall. "Inspired by our tremendous growth over the last two years, we have chosen a challenging and diverse group of works. This concert has been described as full of encores; we only need to decide which one to choose!"
