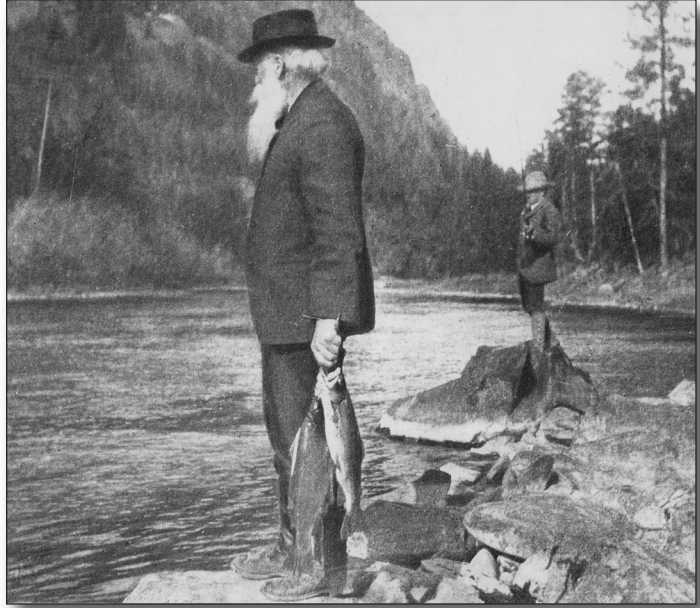


DOUGLAS BRINKLEY

Award-winning author and historian Douglas Brinkley gives his first public talk on literary naturalist and Hudson Valley native John Burroughs. Burroughs' nature essays influenced the emerging conservation movement of the early 20th Century — as did his friendships with national leaders.

Dr. Brinkley is a professor of history at Rice University, a CBS News commentator, and a contributing editor at *Vanity Fair* magazine. He is the author of the acclaimed *Wilderness Warrior: Theodore Roosevelt and the Crusade for America* and is currently writing *Franklin D. Roosevelt: the Renewal of America*.
