




We then went on a road trip across the southern states, where we travelled over 11,000km in two hire cars, and included twelve states! We visited and used many car washes including the Express Tunnel washes which many in the USA are setting up. We met and spoke to several car wash owners, staff members & customers, and observed how they do it in the "home of car washing ".

We bought an esky for our road trip, and went to visit dozens of these Ice Vending machines in Arkansas, Tennesee, Georgia, Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas, New Mexico, Arizona & California. We bought ice from every machine type, we spoke to several machine operators, and saw locations of all standards. The southern states have the closest climate to Australia, and there are now over 3,500 Ice Vending Machines in operation.





in Memphis, Music City (Nashville), Jack Daniels factory Lynchburg, Savannah, Daytona Beach, Key Largo & Key West, Bourbon Street New Orleans, the Alamo and the River Walk in San Antonio, a ranch in Texas (west of San Antonio), the OK Corral at Tombstone, Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Sedona, Williams & Seligman on Route 66, car shows in San Diego and Huntington Beach, and Universal Studios in Hollywood.

We found that virtually everywhere we went, the people went out of their way to make us welcome, and once they heard our Aussie accents, they wanted to know all about Australia. We were able to confirm their stories of snakes, huge kangaroos and crocs! The hospitality, and good old fashioned manners of the people of the south made our trip so enjoyable.
