Philip Moore will join Christ Church Christiana Hundred as our Musician in Residence from April 16-17. Our Musician in Residence program began in 1983 and brings a world-renowned musician to Christ Church each year. Over the years, this program has brought many talented musicians to Christ Church, including Stephen Cleobury, Gerre Hancock, Sir Philip Ledger, John Rutter, Sir David Willcocks, and James O'Donnell. Loved and appreciated by parishioners and people throughout the wider community, our internationally-recognized music program is well known for its contribution to the advancement of Anglican music. The Letty Downs Musician in Residence Program is one important component of this program.

After studying at the Royal College of Music, Philip was Assistant Music Master and Organist at Eton College and became Assistant Organist at Canterbury Cathedral in 1968. In 1974 he was appointed Organist and Master of the Choristers at Guildford Cathedral. He succeeded Francis Jackson in 1983 as Organist and Master of the Music at York Minster, a post he held until his retirement in 2008. In 2015 he began a two-year term as President of the Royal College of Organists. Dr. Moore has composed works for organ, including instrumental works, cantatas for choir and orchestra, and many pieces of Church music.
