Yasser Payne is an Associate Professor in the Department of Black American Studies at the University of Delaware. Dr. Payne completed his doctoral work at the Graduate Center-City University of New York where he was trained as a social-personality psychologist. Dr. Payne has organized a street ethnographic research program entitled: Street Participatory Action Research (Street PAR)—the process of involving members of street identified populations on the actual research team.
