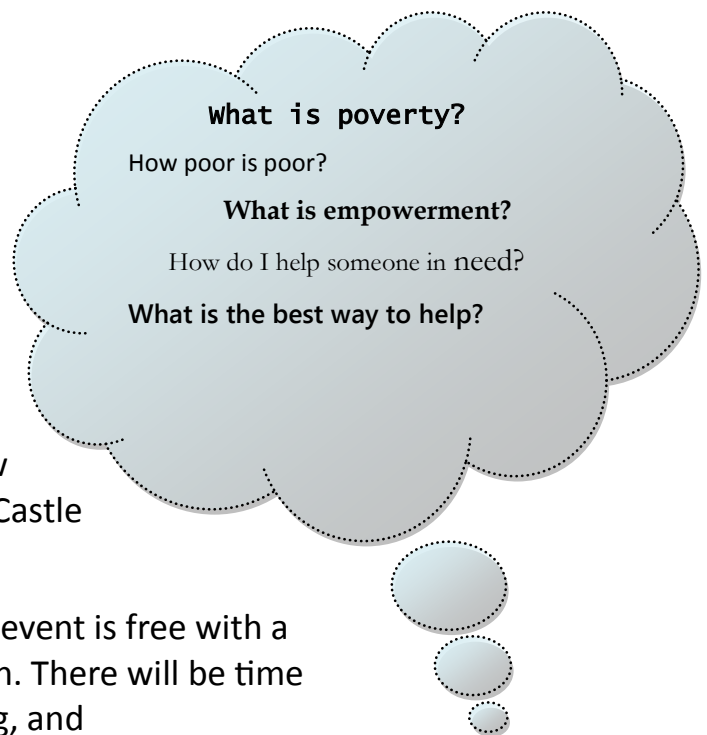
Who should attend?
