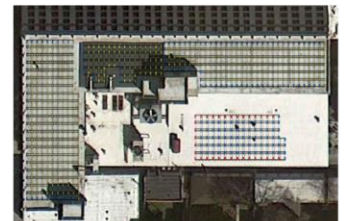

## September 6<sup>th</sup> – Climate Marchers Celebratory Dinner (6:30PM – 9:00PM)

On March 1, 2014, hundreds of climate patriots set out to walk 3,000 miles across America from Los Angeles to Washington, DC with the aim of inspiring action to resolve the climate crisis. The marchers will be holding a rally at Daley Plaza at 2:00 PM. Afterwards, ICA will host around forty marchers for a celebratory potluck at 6:30 PM at ICA GreenRise.

## September 12<sup>th</sup> – Screening of *Fixing the Future* & Mutual Aid Networks (MAN) (6:00PM – 8:30PM)

In *Fixing the Future*, David Brancaccio, of public radio's *Marketplace* and *NOW on PBS*, visits people and organizations across America that are attempting a revolution: the reinvention of the American economy. The film highlights effective, local practices such as local business alliances, community banking, time banking/hour exchange, worker cooperatives and local currencies. The film will be followed by a short reflection, and representatives from the Chicago Time Exchange and MAN will talk about ways you can get involved in alternative economies in Chicago. This event will mark the first 'hub' activity for the Chicago Sustainability Leaders Network.

## September 18<sup>th</sup> - Preparing for Climate Change – Panel Discussion (6:00PM - 8:00 PM)

ICA will be the Uptown-community, virtual-broadcast host site for the "Preparing for Climate Change" panel discussion featuring WGN-TV weatherman, Tom Skilling, Nobel Laureate Dr. Donald Wuebbles, City of Chicago Chief Sustainability Officer, Karen Weigert, and former EPA Administrator, Mary Gade. Metropolitan Planning Council President Mary Sue Barrett will moderate a discussion on public policy implications of a changing climate in the Midwest. While the program will take place at 678 N. Wells, ICA is pleased to host the live stream telecast at the GreenRise Building.

## September 19<sup>th</sup> - Communicating Sustainability in a Polarized Society: An Interactive Workshop (9:00AM - 12:00PM)

Join us for a witty, insightful, and groundbreaking take on one of the most urgent questions of our time: Why, despite overwhelming scientific evidence, do we still ignore climate change? In this interactive workshop, climate change communications expert, George Marshall, provides a short introduction to the latest research in communications - and an opportunity to improve our own narratives. Participants will leave with an understanding of current theory, new tools to analyze their existing communications, and a step by step process for developing narratives for their own audiences.
