

Redistricting Proposal

The 2014-2015 Council of Governors has voted to proceed redistricting process with redistricting MD32 from four districts to two districts (A/D and B/C). The process will begin with a Special Called Convention on May 31, 2015, for a vote on redistricting and end with completed redistricting after the 2017 International Convention in Chicago.

2014-2015 – Council of Governors votes to redistrict and composes a proposal to cover the.

2015-2016 – Duly-elected DGE's are trained for all four districts.

The Proposal for Redistricting is submitted to LCI prior to August 1, 2015. In October, the Proposal is approved at the LCI Board of Directors meeting (which becomes effective in July 2016 at the close of the International Convention in Japan).

2016-2017 – Duly-elected DGE's are trained for all four districts.

To prepare for the future, joint conventions are held for Districts A/D and Districts B/C, co-planned by the leadership of those districts. The CB&L's for the new districts and the multiple district will be worked out during this Lions year. During the business meeting, elections are held for 1st VDG and 2nd VDG (hopefully bringing forward the two Lions who were voted in as 2nd VDGE at the 2015 district conventions). Reflecting LCI, one candidate will need step back to run and serve for year to serve 2017-2018.

2017-2018 – Duly-elected DGE's are trained for the two new districts.

This transitional year will be to work out new positions and policies to cover the new districts/multiple district. All remaining changes should be voted in during the district and multiple district conventions this Lions year. This Lions year should complete the redistricting process.
