

Benefits of Redistricting

Benefits to LCI:

- As defined in the LCI CB&L
- More cost effective
- Following proposed model of “shared leadership:

Benefits to MD32:

- Less cumbersome
- Larger pool of prospective leaders [need ½ the leadership/year]
- Only two district conventions instead of four
- More emphasis on vertical teams/DG leadership team
- More focus on GLT and GMT
- Force more effective use of technology

Benefits to clubs/districts:

- More financial resources for district purposes
- Higher attendance at district conventions

Benefits to Communities:

- More exposure to different projects and opportunities
- No perceivable change to local service; possibly increased service

Benefits to Individual Lions:

- More opportunities for leadership training/networking/personal growth
- Led by better trained, more qualified Lions
