**City of Kingsland Art Contest**

**Friday, April 22nd – Saturday, April 23rd:**  
**"CLEAN-UP CAMDEN" BLITZ**

In conjunction with KEEP GEORGIA BEAUTIFUL and KEEP CAMDEN BEAUTIFUL, a 24-hour litter pick-up event will be held throughout the community on Friday, April 22nd - Saturday, April 23rd. To encourage residents to participate in this community clean-up effort, the Solid Waste Authority will waive the landfill tipping fees on behalf of the Camden County Board of Commissioners. Additionally, Kingsland Public Works will host a "Grace Day" where items that are typically not allowed will be picked up at specific locations. Several litter cleanups will be organized across the Camden community at different locations and volunteers are needed!! Make plans to get your group or civic organization involved in this community event.

*\*\*The Camden County Landfill will receive items at no charge for this event between Noon, Friday, April 22 - Noon, Saturday, April 23. Residents must say they are participating in the Camden Clean-up Blitz to receive this great deal! Items that will NOT be accepted include any Hazardous Waste, Tires, Paints and Bulk Liquids. There will be no exceptions.*
