

**CFC Onscreen Acting Bootcamp –**

The CFC is excited to learn that the City's **Arts & Culture** is shining a spotlight on North York in 2016 through the **Cultural Hotspot** program. The **CFC Onscreen Acting Bootcamp** will take place on Saturdays throughout the months of April and May at the CFC's Northern Dancer Pavilion. It offers a burgeoning talent pool the opportunity to learn and hone new skills through a peer mentorship/coaching experience complete with a final presentation screened for the benefit of friends, family and acting/film professionals. The CFC is thrilled to collaborate with Cultural Hotspot and host this unique signature project to showcase culture, creativity, and community in North York.

**Participants will:**

- Experience voice and movement training
- Receive personal coaching throughout
- Experience a professional on-camera audition and be given tips on how to do "self tapes"
- Experience a film shoot
- Walk away with a head shot for their use and a professionally produced onscreen monologue
- Gain more knowledge about career opportunities in the film/TV acting business
- Experience a showcase of their work

**Accessibility:**

- There is no cost to participate in the project.
- Participants will receive honoraria to be paid out over the course of the bootcamp.
- Participants will be provided with TTC fare (tokens) for travel to and from the CFC.
- CFC will provide participants with lunch and healthy snacks.
- The Northern Dancer Pavilion and the Toronto Centre for the Arts are wheelchair access buildings (equipped with barrier-free washrooms).
- Attendance at the showcase presentation is by invitation only and admission free.

**Showcase Presentation**

Through NYA, CFC will mount a short evening to celebrate the Bootcamp "grads" by screening their monologues to an audience made up of family, friends, acting/film professionals, and the general public. The event will take place at the **Toronto Centre for the Arts** in North York. The date, time and venue are TBC. Representatives from City of Toronto Council and City of Toronto Arts & Culture will be invited to provide opening remarks.
