Difficulty: **Novice**, 14 km, ~ 110 m elevation gain

Sun July 5th — Eagle Mountain, Bighorn Backcountry

Difficulty: **Intermediate**, 15 km, ~ 750 m elevation gain

Sun August 2nd — Tuff Puff, Kootenay Plains Ecological Reserve

Difficulty: **Advanced**, 15 km, ~ 975 m elevation gain

Sun September 6th — Windy Point Scramble, Bighorn Backcountry

Difficulty: **Advanced**, 6 km, ~ 700 m elevation gain
