#### **About the Award**

This is your opportunity to recognize educators or community partners who go above and beyond as they positively affect lives of students and their communities.

Rice Lake Chamber of Commerce Economic Development and Education Committee annually recognizes educators and educational partners who contribute to our communities through direct student involvement or partnership activities. Categories include Innovation in Education, Contributor to Education and Unsung Hero. For purposes of this award, educators and educational partners can be anyone who contributes to effective teaching and learning or educational improvements in our schools and communities. This could include licensed instructors, administrators, counselors, parents, support staff, and volunteers.

To nominate, complete this form and return to the Rice Lake Chamber of Commerce office by Wednesday, September 30, 2015. A committee of the Chamber's Economic Development and Education Committee will review all applications and select award winners. Winners and their nominators will be contacted and invited to attend the Chamber of Commerce Annual Banquet on October 29, 2015 at WITC.

#### **Nomination Criteria**

Nominations can come from anyone in the community and there is no limit to the number of individuals you nominate.

#### **Innovation in Teaching**

This category recognizes individuals who use effective innovative methods or technology in the classroom. For example, consider educators who form partnerships with employers, encourage critical thinking, promote creative problem solving and team building, utilize new technologies, incorporate entrepreneurship, and use other teaching and learning strategies that facilitate the educational process.

#### **Contributor to Education**

This category recognizes someone who is not a licensed educator and who contributes time and effort to student learning and positive educational experiences. These are community people who are instrumental in the lives of youth or in any aspect of teaching and learning within schools, connecting students to service learning or internships and other school-work initiatives, or in other aspects of character building toward development good citizenship.

### **Unsung Hero**

This category honors individuals who improve the quality of life in our schools and communities by building assets, self-esteem, and competencies in others. Their efforts are positive examples of how one individual can positively affect individual lives and communities with short term and long term impact
