It's that time of year again when we honor National Fire Prevention Week during the month of October. This year's theme is "**Hear The Beep Where You Sleep**". The campaign focuses on the importance of a working smoke alarm in your home.

Official Rules:

- Open to all students in Kindergarten – 5th grade, in Hillsborough and Burlingame.
- Poster must illustrate a fire safety theme.
- All entries shall be on 11" x 17" white paper - original artwork only.
- Only 1 artist allowed per poster.
- Student's first and last name, grade, school, and teacher's name, must be written on the attached entry form and taped to the back of the poster

Deadline and judging:

- **Posters are due by Tuesday, October 6th at 9:00am to your school office**
- Central County Fire Department firefighters will conduct judging
- Winners will be announced by **Thursday, October 15th** to your school

Awards:

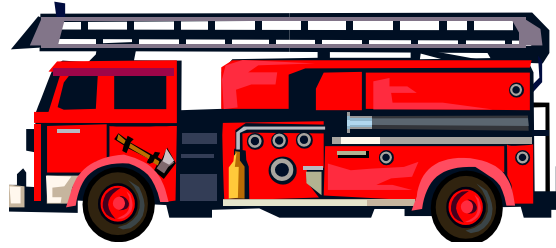

We will present awards at the November 2nd council meeting for Burlingame students and at the November 9th council meeting for Hillsborough students. Posters will be on display at both City Halls during the last two weeks of October through the first week of November.
