To Enroll:

- Log onto your account and click "ENROLL NOW"
- Place a check next to your child's name and click "NEXT"
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and choose "Site Selection" and click "NEXT"
- In the drop down menu choose "Summer 15"
- Place your school's zip code in the zip code field and click "SEARCH"
- Choose the name of the school district name (Roosevelt Burlingame) and click "NEXT"
- Click on "NEXT" and continue the enrollment process.

Once you indicate your child's summer start date, the system will pre-populate your child's attendance through the end of summer. If your child will not be attending all weeks, you will want to go into "Customized Schedule" to customize your child's summer attendance.
