# FORESTERS

## CONTINUING EDUCATION

Foresters are offered 12.5 hours of SAF-CFE credit by attending the lectures specified:

11.5 hours in Category I-CF  
1 hour in Category I-FCA (Forestry Ethics)



**A maximum of 11.5 hours in Category 1-CF** may be earned by attending all six classes offered in the continuing education tents (7 hours), and the field presentations "Hardwood Management," (1.5 hours), "Operator Select Thinning" (1.5 hours), and "Pine Genetics" (1.5 hours). Friday's presentations will be repeated on Saturday, October 6; however, additional credit may not be earned by attending the same class more than once.



**Foresters have two opportunities to fulfill their ethics requirements** (Category 1-FCA credit) by attending "Ethics for Foresters" either on Friday (1 hour) or Saturday (1 hour).  
**A sign-in sheet will be provided** for foresters needing the hours for SAF Certification. For the Mississippi Board of Registration for Foresters, all presentations count as Category A hours.\*
