While going through some mutations over the years it became a tavern in 1967 and started serving food in 1995. It is simply a must see destination when visiting the Eastern Shore.

The "Antique" portion of its name can easily be indentified. It walls are displayed with amazing and unique memorabilia. In fact it holds the world's largest display of Jim Beam decanters on display. Traditionally, it has been the location for the best Seafood Po-Boys, Hamburgers, and Bloody Mary's on the Eastern. Manci's has been featured in Southern Living and Coastal Living magazines as well as Diners, Drive-In's & Dives and Burgers Near and Far TV shows.

Long time restaurateur Harry Johnson teamed up with John Thompson and purchased the restaurant earlier this year from the Manci family. Their goal was to maintain the history of Manci's while injecting the menu and music of John's, Callaghan's Irish Social Club. The upgrades that Harry and JT have made look great and it is fast becoming the destination for great live music on the Eastern Shore. It is truly a fun place to enjoy a few hours, grab a cold beverage and/or an entree, listen to some great entertainment, and enjoy the atmosphere.

The night the Chamber was there we got to use the Buster's Town Hall & Venue Party Room which made it one of the most successful Burger Night events to date. I recommend using the room for your next party. I also want to plug Harry and JT for helping the Chamber acquire some kick butt entertainment for the late September Jubilee Festival. It was topped with four cheeses (Swiss, Pepper jack, Feta, and Cheddar) along with crispy French fried onions, balsamic aioli, and Arcadian lettuce. It was a truly unique blend of flavors and a great burger eating experience.
