The <u>Health Insurance Marketplace</u> is where people can learn about health coverage options and enroll in a health insurance plan.

2016 Open Enrollment:

Health Insurance Marketplace Open Enrollment for coverage in 2016 ended on January 31. The next open enrollment period for coverage in 2017 will begin in the fall of 2016.

Special Enrollment in 2016:

Outside of the annual Open Enrollment some people may be eligible for a Special Enrollment
