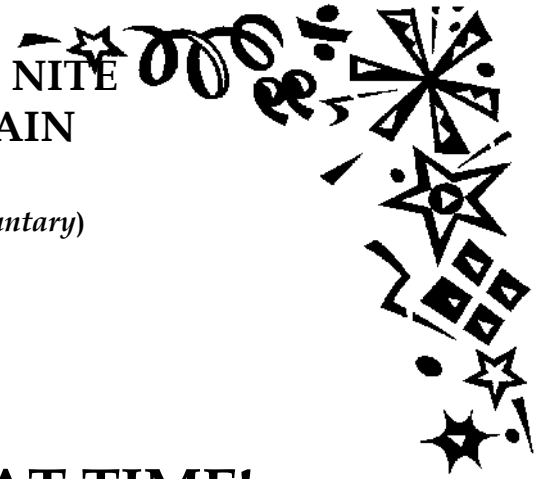

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

Please help us have a fabulous Grad Nite by reading these rules and notes. These rules are established so all students will have a fantastic time!

STUDENT RULES

- When you arrive at Magic Mountain, be prepared for a protective search by Security Personnel. The following items will be confiscated: Food, alcohol, drugs, knives, firearms/ weapons, sharp objects (including jewelry), mace/pepper spray, liquid paper, pens, pencils and magic markers.
- Large bags, purses, backpacks or coolers will not be permitted in the park. Leave them at home.
- The bus company and chaperones are not responsible for items left on the bus while in the park. Leave valuables at home.
- Students must wait their turn in each line. Line jumping and saving places is strictly prohibited.
- Students must properly use all ride safety equipment and follow park rules.
- Students must stay within the park at all times. No one may leave the park before closing. All gates are closed at 7pm and no one may leave the park until 12 midnight, unless the entire group is together, then they are allowed to depart.
- Disorderly conduct or any behavior deemed inappropriate by Magic Mountain staff or School's chaperones will not be permitted. This means fighting, obscene language, shoplifting, bullying, teasing, etc.
- Dress appropriately. Clothing that displays inappropriate words, phrases or graphics are prohibited. Magic Mountain may deny park entry.
- Know your limit when going on rides. Students who do not feel well must contact a chaperone.
- Student roll call will be conducted on the bus before departing RHP and Magic Mountain.
- Students will stay seated on the bus. The bus company does not allow eating or drinking on the bus.
- Students understand there will be an RHP/ REN chaperone at Magic Mountain West Picnic Area (in the park) for any student needs.
- Park personnel will be called to any medical emergencies.
- Students will be advised where and when to meet prior to scheduled departure. Students are expected to meet at designated location on time!
- Students who break rules will either spend the evening in the park Security Office or his/her parents will be called to pick up the child. Consequences will be determined by School administration.

NOTES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- **\$75 covers the cost of admission + coach transportation (submit payment online).**
- **Magic Mountain does not permit the entry of private vehicles for this special event so be on time. Don't miss the bus!**
- Make sure students bring spending money for food, souvenirs, etc.
- Students will be transported by a third party transportation company.
- Chaperones understand that their cell phone numbers will be given to students as emergency contacts.
- Chaperones are required to stay at RHP campus until the final student on their bus is picked up by their parents.
- Magic Mountain dedicates this night to Middle School graduation groups only - The general public is not in attendance.
- The park establishes Magic Mountain West Picnic Area as a central meeting place for chaperones from all schools. At least one RHP chaperone will be at Magic Mountain West Picnic Area all night.
- Magic Mountain has advised us that a First Aid area is available.
- Magic Mountain does not allow the use of annual passes for this special event.
- Magic Mountain stated they may operate in the event of rain.
- Parents must pickup their children from school by 12:00 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS!

PERMISSION, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS, WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

I hereby give my child full and unequivocal permission to voluntarily participate in the **8th GRADE GRAD NITE** field trip to Six Flags Magic Mountain on **Friday MAY 13, 2016**. I, the undersigned, acknowledge and fully understand that my child will be engaging in activities such as bus rides, roller coaster rides, arcades, shops, restaurants, etc. that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses, which might result not only from their own action, inactions or negligence, but the actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises, or of any equipment used. All persons making the field trip shall be deemed to have waived all claims against Rolling Hills Prep School, its affiliates, officers, board of trustees, agents, employees and volunteers for bodily injury, emotional distress, property damage and/or wrongful death occurring to the student, arising out of or in any way connected with this expedition, including, but not limited to those claims arising out of any negligence on the part of Rolling Hills Prep School, its affiliates, officers, board of trustees, agents, employees and volunteers, except only those claims due to willful injury to student, or in violation by law by Rolling Hills Prep School, its affiliates, officers, board of trustees, agents, employees, and volunteers, whether willful or negligent.
