Every other week, July 18 through November 7th

We need one car headed to each site. A wagon or SUV with the seats down is the smallest car recommended!

Quick Glance Schedule:

7:00am - Recommended departure time from PCCT

7:40am - Arrive at America's Grow-a-Row (AGAR)

Pick-up produce labeled Newark 1 from the loading area

8:00am - Depart AGAR

9:00AM – Arrive at Clinton AME Zion Church (their market runs 9am - 12)

Unload produce and prep for market

9:15am Depart after unloading

Before leaving - pick up any remaining corn bags and boxes from the previous week. Drop them off at PCCT to give to the next group to return to the farm.

**Addresses, Directions, Timing, Notes:**

- Return any extra corn bags or boxes from previous market to PCCT or AGAR
- At 1<sup>st</sup> 2 markets for each site – provide AGAR reusable bags

**PCCT to America's Grow-a-Row, 150 Pittstown Road, Pittstown, NJ:**

Distance: 35 miles, 40 minutes, no traffic. Recommend leaving Chatham around 7:00am.

- 78 West to Exit 15, Clinton/Pittstown 173-E
- Left at stop-light onto County Road 513S/Pittstown-Clinton Road.
- Go 1.9 miles and AGAR is on the right.

Pull into the parking lot and park in the front. The produce will be under the overhang on the right side of the building when you are facing it, labeled for NEWARK. **Only take these boxes/bags marked for your site (Newark Market 1 –Clinton Church**

**FROM AGAR TO NEWARK MARKET 1: Clinton AME Zion Church: 151 Broadway,**

**Newark, NJ 07104**

- Make a left out of the AGAR parking lot
- Go 1.9 miles and bear right onto 78 East
- Go 36.8 miles and take Exit 52 for the Garden State Parkway
- Take Exit 145 towards Newark/Harrison; merge onto I-280 East
- Take Exit 14 for MLK Blvd towards Broad St Station/Rutgers U/Essex Co College
- Turn right on Crittenden St.
- Turn right on Broadway. Church will be on the left.

Park on the street or in the lot. Unload produce with help of Clinton Church volunteers for the market in the parking lot.

Take any boxes/bags from the previous visit back to the church.
