With regard to this year's Summer Olympics, Troop 321 will be hosting the GOOFBALL OLYMPICS. These Games have one objective, to have fun.

The requirements to enter the Olympic Games:

- Each team (Troop or Patrol) will consist of 4-9 players
- Each team will name itself after a fictitious country. (a Troop that splits into 2 patrols may choose to be East & West _____ or North & South _____)

Each team will bring a 2' X 4' flag attached to a 6' +- pole with "country", Troop #, Charter organization and anything else they want printed on it. The pole must have a diameter small enough to fit inside a 1 ½" pvc pipe.

Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in a substantial deduction of points to start the games.

To earn bonus points to start the games, you may choose to:

- All team members wear their fictitious country's attire. (ie Scotland- Kilts, Rome-Togas, Germany- Lederhosen)
 - Sing your fictitious country's national anthem at the opening ceremonies.
 - Any other Olympic idea that lends your team to stand out from the others.

Awards will be given to the top teams at the closing ceremonies. There will also be special recognition awards given for goofball antics and other fun spirit. The traveling Golden skilnet award will be presented to the most outstanding team (a combination of Team competition and Team spirit). "IT'S NOT WHETHER YOU WIN OR LOSE, BUT HOW YOU PLAY THE GAMES".
