10:00 A.M. – Scavenger Hunt/Hike

Scouts can complete a scavenger hunt while hiking approximately 5 miles seeing historical points around downtown Wabash, IN. Maps can be picked up at the Honeywell Center. This is a “do it on your own” activity, and you should allow 2 to 3 hours to complete it.

1:30 P.M. - Registration and Hands on Advancement Activities - Six activity stations, US Flag =learning about the flag and how to fold and handle it. US Coins=learning the parts & marks of coins, weights and coin rubbings, along with a game. American Tall Tales=reading a American Tall Tale, create their own, do in a small art project, and play a game from the past, Scouting History=learn about the history of Scouting, creating a time line, and seeing memorabilia, Local Hero=learn how citizens can be heroes, and recognize a hero in your community, Local Government=meet local elected officials, learn what they do, learn the rights and duties of a citizen, learn how laws are made.

3:10 P.M. - Program - A short program opening with a flag ceremony, and featuring presentations by several Boy Scout and local political dignitaries. There will also be Advancement activities as part of this short program.

3:30 P.M. – Parade - Cub Scout Packs and Boy Scout Troops will join together in a short parade up the hill to the Wabash County Court House and the Abraham Lincoln Statue, where Abe will address the crowd. – **BRING YOUR PACK AND TROOP FLAGS ALONG WITH YOUR AMERICAN FLAG FOR COLOR GUARD FOR THE PARADE.**
